
Introduction

 willing to debate the issue speaks deafening volumes.






- Did not appear a devious, hardened or rebellious individual (at least early in life)
- Loved his family and his believing wife, and had reservations about publishing his ideas lest he upset her.
- In many respects, he can be considered a product of his environment.

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Enter Charles Darwin

- 1. Churches in England had previously conceded to uniformitarianism and the age of the earth, but refused to accept evolution.
- 2. Darwin's paternal family was non-religious, and his grandfather, Erasmus, believed and taught evolution.
- 3. Darwin's mother was a Unitarian and sent him to a religious school, she died when he was young, but he still believed in the authenticity of the Bible.
- 4. Darwin could not accept conventional orthodox teaching of the day that his paternal family was going to hell.



(Take-Home Message from Sections I-IV)


- Uniformitarianism and the age of the earth is a well-documented stepping stone used by evolutionists on the path to belief in evolution.



VI. My Personal Recommendation

Instead of (1) making "accommodations" with any "here today, gone tomorrow" pop philosophy and/or pop science, or (2) capitulating divine truth for the sake of popular science, why don't theologians and believing scientists (A) move away from political maneuvering, (B) resolve whether or not the scriptures contain ultimate truth; and if they do, then (C) we can focus on what is truly important – an honest an unbiased assessment of the scientific and theological evidences and arguments for or against creation and evolution, rather than subjugating the Bible to the humanists "scientific" arguments.

VII. Thirty Scientific and Philosophical Arguments Against neo-Darwinism

- 1. Some evolutionists admit that ND "natural selection" is based on tautological reasoning.
- 2. Gene mutation-based evolution (i.e., neo-Darwinism) has been debunked. Scientists that understand this are furiously searching for a new mechanism to "remix" the evolutionary hypothesis before the general public catches on. (See the book, *The Altenberg 16: An Expose* of the Evolution Industry by S. Muzur, 2010.)
 - A. Conferences have been held in Altenberg, Austria (July 10-13, 2008) and Rome (Mar. 3-7, 2009) to discuss re-synthesizing the mechanism required for macroevolution.

- 23. In the trillions of experimental generation cycles of bacteria tested by scientists in laboratory settings, these microorganisms have never been induced into evolving into anything other than bacteria (i.e. no macroevolution).
- 24. Philosophers have been proposing evolution (without any scientific proof) at least since Thales in 588 B.C. Western Europe's 18th century Biblical criticism, modernism and atheism had been looking for a "scientific explanation for evolution" in order to explain away God 100 years before Darwin's publication. For this reason, Darwin's arguments, as weak as they were, (e.g., Lamarckian evolution, and murder of the "savage races") were touted as truth.
- 25. True science requires application of the scientific method. Neo-Darwinism isn't founded on the four-tiered scientific method.
- 26. Historical scientists, all the way back to 1859 as well as thousands of doctoral scientists, physicians, surgeons and philosophers around the world have voiced their opposition to ND as a viable explanation for the complexity of life.

- 27. The so-called "convergent evolution" (i.e., simultaneous identically-evolved anatomical structures in different animals) of organs such as human and octopus eyes requires more faith to believe than does creation.
- 28. Blood alpha-hemoglobin of the crocodile is more similar to the chicken than it is to a supposedly more closely-related animal, the viper, which is a conundrum for macroevolutionary-inherited similarities.
- 29. Dinosaur tracks in the grand canyon are consistently found in lower strata than their bones, which is a conundrum for Darwinists, but is exactly what creationists expect to find based on the Noahic flood.

- 30. To justify macroevolution, proponents frequently resort to an "appeal to the majority."
 - Majority opinion has <u>never</u> established truth on any scientific subject, including the rotundity of the earth, geocentrism versus heliocentrism, early 19th-century forced sterilization of the mentally-ill in the United States, majority support for the scientific arguments in favor of the Holocaust by scientists and philosophers in Nazi Germany, bleeding to treat the ill, lobotomies to treat the mentally ill, the steady state theory of the universe, etc.

Conclusions

- •The scientific weaknesses of neo-Darwinian evolution have been thoroughly dealt with, and are well-documented. Christians should be aware of and acquainted with these types of apologetic resources.
- •ND evolution is a major tool used to destroy faith in the written word of God.
- •The intelligent-design movement represents a "big tent" in which all believers may unite, but caution should be exercised when supporting those who teach theistic evolution.
- •My opinion is that there <u>may</u> be a continuum of sacrificing Biblical truth to accommodate pop science, seen in the following. (NOTE: Loss of faith in the veracity and authority of the scripture <u>may</u> be more likely to occur the further one moves down the continuum.)
- A. Acceptance of a uniformitarian age of the earth (currently 4.54 billion years old).
 - B. Denial of the literal six-day account of creation.
- C. Acceptance of inorganic evolution of the universe and earth prior to God creating biological life (inorganic old earth creationism).
 - D. Acceptance of organic old earth creationism.
 - **E.** Acceptance of theistic evolution.
 - F. Acceptance of deistic evolution (e.g. BioLogos).
